SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATIONS

Important Notice Regarding Your ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan Coverage

To: All Eligible ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan Enrollees

Subject: Life, Accidental Death, and Accidental Dismemberment Benefits

Effective July 1, 2022, the Life, Accidental Death, and Accidental Dismemberment Benefit for Active Longshore Workers is increased to \$70,000 and increased for Retired Longshore Workers to \$30,000.

The Supplemental Summary Plan Description is updated to read as shown below. Please remember to keep your Beneficiary Designation form up to date to account for any life events such as marriage, divorce, new dependents, etc. Blank forms can be obtained at www.benefitplans.org, at your union local office, your Area Welfare Director, or the ILWU-PMA Benefit Plans Office.

Life, Accidental Death, and Accidental Dismemberment Benefit Amounts

Program I: Active Longshore Worker

Life Benefit \$70,000

Accidental Death and Accidental Dismemberment Benefit \$70,000

Life and Accidental Death benefits are paid to the Active Longshore Workers' designated beneficiary. Accidental Dismemberment benefits are paid to the eligible Active Longshore Worker.

(OVER)

Under IRS rules, if the total value of your life insurance is above \$50,000, the imputed cost of coverage in excess of \$50,000 is considered imputed (taxable) income. Since the Life insurance benefit amount is above \$50,000 for the Active Longshore Worker the cost of additional life insurance of \$20,000 is subject to imputed income tax. This means this will be reported on your W-2 and you will be responsible for paying tax on the cost of life insurance benefit of \$20,000.

Program II: Retired Longshore Worker

Life Benefit \$30,000

Accidental Death and Accidental Dismemberment Benefit \$30,000

Life and Accidental Death benefits are paid to the Retired Longshore Workers' designated beneficiary. Accidental Dismemberment benefits are paid to the eligible Retired Longshore Worker.
