New Delta Dental Network Effective April 1, 2020 – Delta Dental PPO

This change will allow for two networks of dentists to reduce your out-of-pocket costs when utilizing PPO network dentists.

On the "Select Network" dropdown, you can use Delta Dental PPO to search for dentists in the new network, or Delta Dental Premier, to search for dentists in the current network.
