Subject: ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan New Delta Dental Network Effective November 1, 2020 – Delta Dental PPO

This notice applies to all ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan members and beneficiaries enrolled in any of the dental plans who utilize dental implant services and children enrolled in the Delta Dental Children's Program on or after November 1, 2020.

Effective November 1, 2020, the Delta Dental PPO Network will be added to the ILWU-PMA Welfare Plan's Delta Dental Children's Program and the Dental Implant program.

The Delta Dental PPO Network is being provided as an option to you in addition to the current Delta Dental Premier Network. You will be allowed to continue utilizing dentists in the current Delta Dental Premier Network and receive the same out-of-pocket savings you have been receiving. This change will allow for two networks of dentists to reduce your out-of-pocket costs when utilizing PPO network dentists.

To search for dentists in the Delta Dental PPO Network, visit <u>www.deltadentalins.com</u> and use the Find a Dentist section on the right side of the screen. On the "Select Network" dropdown, you can use Delta Dental PPO to search for dentists in the new network, or Delta Dental Premier, to search for dentists in the current network.

Can I ask my dentist to join the PPO network?

Yes. Visit deltadentalins.com/recommend

to recommend your dentist for the PPO network. Although the final decision is up to your dentist, your encouragement might help him or her decide. During your next appointment, you can also ask your dentist about joining the PPO network.

How can I tell if my dentist is Premier or PPO?

Your dentist might already be a PPO dentist. To find out, visit **deltadentalins.com**. In the **Find a Dentist section**, enter your location, network and your dentist's name. You can also call your dential office and ask whether your dentist is a contracted Delta Dental PPO dentist.

What's the difference between a Premier dentist and a PPO dentist?

PPO dentists have agreed to reduced fees, which leaves more money in your pocket. Visit a dentist in our robust, nationwide PPO network to maximize your savings.
